SEEDS & SPORES (Change of Season)

Gr. K-2 Drive in - 1.5 hours \$60.00

Gr. 3-7 Walk in - 2 hours \$65.00

Students will be introduced to seasonal changes affecting plant lifecycles. The focus will be on the interconnection of animals and plants in the environment.

FOREST DETECTIVES

Gr. K-2 Drive in - 1.5 hours-\$60.00

Gr. 3-7 Walk in - 2 hours -\$65.00

Students will search for signs of biodiversity in the forest community using observation, investigation and deduction skills.

EXPLORING NATURE

Grades K-2 Drive in - 1.5 hour \$60.00

A short nature walk, focusing on our local plant and animal life. The children are encouraged to use their senses to explore the forest environment.

NATURE WALK

Grades 3-7 Walk in - 2 hours \$65.00

This program provides a study of our Coastal Douglas-Fir ecosystem and the relationship between plants, animals, and non-living elements.

Students will explore biodiversity in a forest community through intentional observation, interpretation, and reasoning.

Morrell Sanctuary is a mature second growth forest. This program will also show students how to identify 7 of the most common trees found in our beautiful woodlands.
